

**CITY OF COLUMBIA, ILLINOIS**  
**ORDINANCE NO. 3449**

**AN ORDINANCE STRIKING THE TEXT FROM SECTION 5.20.240 OF THE CITY OF  
COLUMBIA LIQUOR CODE**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Columbia (“City Council”) previously adopted Chapter 5.20 of the City of Columbia Municipal Code (“Liquor Code”); and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council believes it is in the best interest of the City of Columbia (“City”) to amend Section 5.20.240 to remove a requirement pertaining to the sale of alcohol with meals from the City’s liquor code.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** That the preceding recitations in the upper part of this Ordinance are realleged, restated and adopted as paragraph one (“1”) of this Ordinance.

**Section 2.** That Section 5.20.240 of the Liquor Code shall be amended to read as follows:

**“Section 5.20.240      Reserved”**

**Section 3.** That the remaining paragraphs in Section 5.20 shall remain the same.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as provided by law.


