

**CITY OF COLUMBIA, ILLINOIS
ORDINANCE NO. 3449**

**AN ORDINANCE STRIKING THE TEXT FROM SECTION 5.20.240 OF THE CITY OF
COLUMBIA LIQUOR CODE**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Columbia ("City Council") previously adopted Chapter 5.20 of the City of Columbia Municipal Code ("Liquor Code"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it is in the best interest of the City of Columbia ("City") to amend Section 5.20.240 to remove a requirement pertaining to the sale of alcohol with meals from the City's liquor code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the preceding recitations in the upper part of this Ordinance are realleged, restated and adopted as paragraph one ("1") of this Ordinance.

Section 2. That Section 5.20.240 of the Liquor Code shall be amended to read as follows:

"Section 5.20.240 Reserved"

Section 3. That the remaining paragraphs in Section 5.20 shall remain the same.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as provided by law.


