

**CITY OF COLUMBIA, ILLINOIS
ORDINANCE NO. 3455**

**AN ORDINANCE REVISING LICENSING REQUIREMENTS AND REGULATIONS
FOR CERTAIN TYPES OF BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS**

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia ("City"), Monroe and St. Clair Counties, Illinois is a duly created, organized and validly existing municipality of the State of Illinois under the 1970 Illinois Constitution and the laws of the State of Illinois, including particularly the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto; and

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia Municipal Code ("City Code") provides licensing requirements and regulations for businesses located within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City finds it is necessary to revise certain requirements of Chapter 5 of the City Code in order to promote a more business-friendly environment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia, as follows:

Section 1. That the preceding recitations in the upper part of this Ordinance are realleged, restated and adopted as paragraph one ("1") of this Ordinance.

Section 2. That Section 05.04.110 "Coin-Operated Vending Machines" of the City Code shall be deleted in its entirety.

Section 3. That Section 05.04.230 "Business Vehicles" of the City Code shall be deleted in its entirety.

Section 4. That Chapter 05.46 "Coin-Operated Amusement Devices" of the City Code shall be deleted in its entirety.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Corporate Authorities.

Alderman Niemietz moved the adoption of the above and foregoing Ordinance; the motion was seconded by Alderman Ebersohl, and the roll call vote was as follows:


