ORDINANCE NO. 3467

**AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE A RIGHT-OF-WAY PLAT AND ACCEPT
DEDICATION OF THE CORRESPONDING RUECK ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY**

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia ("City"), Monroe and St. Clair Counties, Illinois is a duly created, organized and validly existing municipality of the State of Illinois under the 1970 Illinois Constitution and the laws of the State of Illinois, including particularly the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto; and

WHEREAS, the City has deemed the extension of Rueck Road as vital to the long-term growth of Columbia and planned for such extension to ultimately connect to Old State Route 3 or Mule Road; and

WHEREAS, the recent sale of a portion of St. Clair County Parcel No. 1104040007 has necessitated said right-of-way dedication to ensure the resulting parcel has access to public right-of-way.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia, as follows:

Section 1. The preceding recitations in the upper part of this Ordinance are realleged, restated and adopted as paragraph one ("1") of this Ordinance.

Section 2. The Rueck Road Right-of-Way Dedication Plat, attached as Exhibit A, is hereby approved and the corresponding right-of-way dedication is hereby accepted.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Corporate Authorities, as provided by law.

Alderman Ebersohl moved the adoption of the above and foregoing Ordinance; the motion was seconded by Alderman Huch, and the roll call vote was as follows:


