**AN ORDINANCE TO FILL THE OFFICES OF APPOINTED CITY OFFICERS FOR
THE FISCAL YEAR OF THE CITY ENDING APRIL 30, 2010.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Illinois, (the "City"), and Division 30 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/3.1-30-5), City Officers are to be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the City Council;

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code further provides that the salary of said appointed officers is to be fixed by ordinance and may be increased but may not be diminished so as to take effect during their term of office (65 ILCS 5/3.1-50-5).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Full-Time Appointed City Officers.

The following persons are hereby appointed to fill the following appointed City offices for the one (1) year term beginning May 1, 2009 and ending April 30, 2010:

- Joseph Edwards, Chief of Police and EMS Director
- Jerry Paul, Deputy Chief of Police
- Ronald J. Williams, City Engineer and Director of Public Works

and

The following individual is hereby appointed to fill the following appointed City offices for the period beginning on June 15, 2009 and ending April 30, 2010:

- Albert G. Hudzik, City Administrator, Budget Officer, Health Officer and NIMS Coordinator

Section 2. Part-Time Appointed City Officers.

The following persons are hereby appointed to fill the following part-time appointed City offices for the one (1) year term beginning May 1, 2009 and ending April 30, 2010, for the salary or compensation set opposite their respective names:

- Al Holden, Americans with Disabilities Act Coordinator	\$ - 0 -
- Randy Rudloff, Plumbing Inspector	\$ 35/Inspection

The following individual is hereby appointed to fill the following part-time appointed City office for the period beginning June 15, 2009 and ending April 30, 2010, for the salary or compensation set opposite the individual's name:

Section 3. Professional Appointed City Officers.

The following Professional City Officers are hereby appointed for the period of time and the compensation as described in the text of subparagraphs (A) and (B) of this Section 3, to-wit:

(A) City Attorney. The City states herein that it has recently published its Request for Qualifications for Legal Services to assist in its determination of the law firm to be appointed as its City Attorney. Until another law firm is appointed to the office of City Attorney, the Law Firm of Adams and Huetsch, Attorneys-at-Law, shall continue to serve in its capacity as City Attorney; it shall no longer serve in such capacity whenever its successor (to the office of City Attorney) is appointed and qualifies to hold said office, or on April 30, 2010, whichever of those dates occurs first. For usual and customary legal services - including preparation and/or review of city ordinances and resolutions required for corporate action to be taken by the City, consulting with and rendering legal advice to the Mayor, the City Council, and the other elected and appointed city officers of the city on all legal questions affecting the City; for the prosecution or defense of all suits

or legal actions in which the City, or any of its Officers, acting in the course and scope of their official duties may be a party (for which a defense is not provided by the Illinois Municipal League Risk Management Association as the city insurer); negotiations and documentation of routine city financial matters (including lease-purchase agreements and installment sales agreements for the purpose of real or personal property by the City) - fees for these services will be billed at the hourly rate of \$135.00 for the Senior Partner Tom Adams, and at the hourly rate of \$90.00 for an Associate Attorney.

Special projects requiring special expertise or extraordinary work and effort such as bond issue financing (including revenue, general obligation, and alternate bonds) may require additional fees to be assessed and paid in accordance with what is usual and customary for such legal services.

(B) City Auditor. The Certified Public Accounting Firm of Schorb and Schmersahl, LLC is appointed as City Auditor for the one (1) year term beginning May 1, 2009 and ending April 30, 2010. The firm of Schorb and Schmersahl, LLC shall perform its audit of the financial statements for all funds of the City in compliance with all applicable accounting and auditing standards pertaining to municipal audits in the State of Illinois. Additional duties may include assistance/consultation on other financial issues upon request by the City. The compensation for services rendered by Schorb and Schmersahl, LLC pursuant hereto are to be detailed in an engagement letter, which shall require City Council approval.

Section 4.

The annual salaries and compensation to be paid to the Section 1. Full-Time Appointed City Officers (appointed herein), shall be determined and detailed in a separate ordinance; until such separate salary and compensation ordinance is properly approved, each of said Full-Time Appointed City Officers shall continue to receive the annual salary and compensation they were receiving, respectively, immediately prior to their appointment herein.

Section 5.

All ordinances, resolutions, or orders of the City in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed.

Section 6.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, as provided by law.




