ORDINANCE NO. 2722

**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF A 1994
FORD E350 AMBULANCE OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA,
ILLINOIS TO EMERGENCY SERVICES SUPPLY OF ST.
LOUIS, MISSOURI AS SURPLUS CITY PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia, Illinois (the "City") is an Illinois municipality having a population of under 500,000; the corporate authority of which is a city council comprised of a mayor and eight (8) aldermen;

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code, in pertinent part, provides and allows that an Illinois municipality having a population of less than 500,000, by simple majority vote of its corporate authorities, may by ordinance authorize the sale of items of its surplus personal property in such manner as said corporate authorities may designate, with or without advertising the same for sale (65 ILCS 5/11-76-4);

WHEREAS, the City owns and possesses a 1994 Ford E350 ambulance vehicle, which the City Council of the City has determined to be surplus City property having an approximate value of \$4,000, and which the City has an opportunity to sell to Emergency Services Supply of St. Louis, Missouri, by private sale and without the need and expense of advertising the ambulance for sale;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City has found and determined and does hereby declare that it is in the welfare and best interest of the City that the City accept the offer of Emergency Services Supply to purchase the ambulance for a cash sales price of \$4,000 as soon as practicable; and,

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is enacted in order to authorize the sale of the ambulance aforesaid for the price aforesaid and to authorize the Interim City Administrator to represent the City in the sale and to execute any documents required to accomplish the sale for and on behalf of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The recitals contained above in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference, the same as if set forth in this Section of this Ordinance verbatim, as findings of the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois.

Section 2. The City Council hereby and herewith authorizes the sale of the City's 1994 Ford E350 Ambulance (having Vehicle Identification No. 1FDKE30M2RHB48868) to Emergency Services Supply, located at 6641 Christopher Drive, St. Louis, Missouri 63129, for the cash sale price of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000), as soon as is practicable after the enactment of this Ordinance; and, does hereby authorize and direct the Interim City Administrator, Albert G. Hudzik, to execute

and deliver the motor vehicle title for said vehicle and any and all other documents necessary to be signed and delivered in order to consummate said sale, for and on behalf of the City, in as many counterparts as he, the Interim City Administrator, shall determine.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, as provided by law.

Alderman Stumpf moved the adoption of the above and foregoing Ordinance; the motion was seconded by Alderman Hejna, and the roll call vote was as follows:
