ORDINANCE NO. 2737

**AN ORDINANCE RENAMING
PARKVIEW DRIVE AND EDELWEISS DRIVE
AS
VETERANS PARKWAY**

WHEREAS, the citizens of Columbia are grateful for, and are the beneficiaries of, the sacrifices that the Veterans of the community of Columbia, as well as the Veterans of all of America, have made, and continue to make, to protect our freedoms and preserve our way of life in America;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, deems it appropriate to recognize the sacrifices and hardships that our Veterans and their loved ones have endured throughout the years and continue to endure at this time for the benefit of freedom-loving people throughout the world;

WHEREAS, the naming of a street that connects three of the main streets of the City of Columbia, Illinois, and runs along or near three of the schools that educate the youth of our community is deemed to be an appropriate way to honor the Veterans of the community of Columbia, Illinois, and of all of America, and also recognize the sacrifices of their loved ones.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. As of 12:01 AM on Veterans Day, November 11, 2009, the street named "Parkview Drive" from Main Street to Admiral Parkway and the street named "Edelweiss Drive" from Admiral Parkway to Valmeyer Road are hereby renamed "Veterans Parkway".

Section 2. The provisions of all ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect, from and after its passage, as provided by law.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form.

Alderman Niemietz moved the adoption of the above and foregoing Ordinance; the motion was seconded by Alderman Ebersohl, and the roll call vote was as follows:


