WHY YOU ARE RECEIVING THIS NOTICE

The Illinois EPA reported a PFOS result exceeding the applicable standard in the **Village of Dupo Water System**. Illinois EPA has directed Columbia to notify its customers under Illinois “Right-to-Know” laws because Columbia has an **EMERGENCY** interconnection with the Village of Dupo’s water system.

KEY FACTS FOR COLUMBIA CUSTOMERS

- Your drinking water is supplied through Illinois American Water.
- The Columbia–Dupo interconnection exists to provide **EMERGENCY** backup water **TO DUPO**.
- Under normal operating conditions, Dupo water **CANNOT** flow into Columbia through this connection due to differing system pressures.
- The hydraulic flow direction is **Columbia → Dupo**.
- This interconnection has not been utilized to supply water to Dupo since 2016.
