ORDINANCE NO. 2897

**AN ORDINANCE REAFFIRMING ORDINANCE NO. 2890
ADOPTED ON SEPTEMBER 6, 2011 ENTERING INTO AN
ANNEXATION AGREEMENT WITH THE IMMACULATE
CONCEPTION ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH OF
COLUMBIA, ILLINOIS.**

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia, Illinois (the "City") adopted Ordinance No. 2890 on September 6, 2011 entering into an annexation agreement with the Immaculate Conception Roman Catholic Church of Columbia, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, it has now been determined the Catholic Diocese of Belleville, Illinois is to be a party to said annexation agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The recitals contained above in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference, the same as if set forth in this Section of this Ordinance verbatim, as findings of the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois.

Section 2. The City Council hereby reaffirms the adoption of Ordinance No. 2890 adopted on September 6, 2011 entering into an annexation agreement with the Immaculate Conception Roman Catholic Church with the Catholic Diocese of Belleville, Illinois as a party to the agreement.

Section 3. The annexation agreement shall be amended to add the Catholic Diocese of Belleville, Illinois as a party to the agreement with the appropriate notarized signature page for the Catholic Diocese of Belleville, Illinois added to the annexation agreement.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.

Alderman Reis moved the adoption of the above and foregoing Ordinance; the motion was seconded by Alderman Roessler, and the roll call vote was as follows:




