

ORDINANCE NO. 2902

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 1408 WHICH PROVIDED FOR THE AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING OF A COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR THE PROPOSED "SITZES SUBDIVISION" WITH REGARD TO THE CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF A SIDEWALK ON WHITESIDE AVENUE IN SAID SUBDIVISION.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois adopted Ordinance No. 1408 on December 18, 1995 authorizing and approving a cooperation agreement for the proposed "Sitzes Subdivision" for the construction and installation of a sidewalk on Whiteside Avenue in said Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the sidewalk to be guaranteed to be constructed and installed as part of said cooperation agreement has subsequently been constructed and installed; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 1408 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. All ordinances, resolutions, or orders in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed.

Alderman Reis moved the adoption of the above and foregoing Ordinance; the motion was seconded by Alderman Huch, and the roll call vote was as follows:




