Aldermen in attendance were: Niemietz and Reis.


Administrative Staff in attendance were: City Administrator Al Hudzik and City Clerk J. Ronald Colyer.


Guests: Attorney Tom D. Adams representing Mark and Tamara Kohlenberger.
