AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A
REPLACEMENT MEMBER TO THE COLUMBIA HERITAGE AND
PRESERVATION COMMISSION FOR THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Columbia Heritage and Preservation Commission shall consist of nine (9) members who are residents of the City or who own real property in the City, four (4) to be appointed on odd numbered years and five (5) to be appointed on even numbered years, are appointed to two (2) year terms by the Mayor with approval of the City Council, excepting that residency requirement may be waived for not more than three (3) members who, in the opinion of the Mayor and the City Council, possess special knowledge or expertise in historic preservation or local history (Municipal Codes Sections 15.64.030, 15.64.040, and 15.64.050); and

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists on the Columbia Heritage and Preservation Commission for a position selected by the Columbia Historical Society with a term expiring April 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to appoint an individual to fill the vacancy on the Columbia Heritage and Preservation Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Columbia Heritage and Preservation Commission: JoAnn Sander is appointed as a member of the Columbia Heritage and Preservation Commission. Such term is to begin immediately and shall expire on April 30, 2017.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect, and the appointment made herein shall be effective immediately, from and after its passage as provided by law.

Section 3. All Ordinances, Resolutions, or Orders in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed.
