**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF CERTAIN PERSONAL  
PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF COLUMBIA**

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the corporate authorities of the City of Columbia ("City"), it is no longer necessary or useful to or for the best interests of the City to retain the following described personal property now owned by it:

Self-Supporting 140' Radio Tower  
(Surplus Property)

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Mayor and City Council that it is in the best interest of the City to dispose of that Surplus Property in the manner described in this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MONROE AND ST. CLAIR COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section One: The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as findings of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia, Monroe and St. Clair Counties, Illinois.

Section Two: Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Columbia, Monroe and St. Clair Counties, Illinois, find that the Surplus Property, now owned by the City of Columbia, is no longer necessary or useful to the City of Columbia, and the best interest of the City of Columbia will be served by its disposal because said Surplus Property has negative value.

Section Three: Pursuant to said Section 11-76-4, the City may sell or dispose of this Surplus Property in the manner most appropriate to the City. The Surplus Property must be sold or disposed of in "as is" condition.

Section Four: The Chief of Police is authorized to dispose of said Surplus Property by transferring it to Wisper Internet on the condition that Wisper Internet moves the three camera antennas from the Surplus Property to the new radio tower and that Wisper Internet takes full responsibility for taking down and moving the old radio tower.

Section Five: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.




