ORDINANCE NO. 2491

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.52.020 (SCHEDULE "B") OF CHAPTER 10.52 (TRAFFIC SCHEDULES) OF TITLE 10 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY GOVERNING STOP INTERSECTIONS IN THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois has determined that it is necessary and appropriate and in the public interest, and upon the recommendation of the Police Chief of the Police Department of the City of Columbia, Illinois, to amend Section 10.52.020 (Schedule "B") of Chapter 10.52 (Traffic Schedules) of Title 10 (Vehicles and Traffic) regarding stop intersections in the City of Columbia, Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Schedule "B" for Section 10.52.020 (Stop Streets) of Traffic Schedules, Chapter 10.52, of TITLE 10 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC) of the Municipal Code of the City is hereby amended to add to the list of stop intersections therein described, the following:

“On the right or East side of Palmer Creek Drive at it’s intersection with Quarry Road”

Section 2. PENALTY. Any person, firm or corporation violating this ordinance shall be fined not less than Fifty (\$50.00) nor more than \$500.00 for each offense.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.

Alderman Ebersohl moved the adoption of the above and foregoing ordinance; the motion was seconded by Alderman Conrad and the Roll Call vote was as follows:
