AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 2.68.320, HOLIDAYS, A., CITY-OBSERVED HOLIDAYS, OF THE PERSONNEL CODE OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois (the "City") has found and determined and does hereby declare that it is necessary and appropriate that the Personnel Code of the City (which Personnel Code comprises Chapter 2.68 of the Columbia Municipal Code) shall be changed and amended as is hereinafter made and provided in this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The recitals contained above in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference, the same as if set forth in this Section of this Ordinance verbatim, as findings of the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois.

Section 2. Section 2.68.320, Holidays, A., City-Observed Holidays, of the City Personnel Code is hereby changed and amended by adding the words "Day After Thanksgiving."

Section 3. The February 7, 2001 Memo of Understanding granting a one-half day holiday on New Year's Eve Day when the day falls between Monday and Friday is hereby repealed.

Section 4. All ordinances, resolutions, or orders in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed.
