AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE A SERVICE CONTRACT TO HIRE TECH ELECTRONIC, INC. OF ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI TO PURCHASE AND INSTALL A PROFESSIONAL SOUND REINFORCEMENT SYSTEM IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER FOR THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois (the "City") has found and determined and does hereby declare that it is necessary and appropriate the City purchase a professional sound reinforcement system for the Council Chamber to provide intelligible sound reinforcement to all participants and observers of public meetings held in said Chamber; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City has determined that the City should employ Tech Electronics, Inc. of St. Louis, Missouri to provide the services aforesaid; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate that this Ordinance be enacted for the use and purpose of authorizing the employment of Tech Electronics, Inc. to provide the aforementioned cleaning services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The recitals contained above in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference, the same as if set forth in this Section of this Ordinance verbatim, as findings of the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois does hereby authorize and direct the Mayor to employ Tech Electronics, Inc. to purchase and install the sound reinforcement system as well as to provide training to City staff on the system.

Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to make and enter into said Service Contract to employ Tech Electronics, Inc. to provide the services aforesaid, in the form attached hereto, which is hereby approved as to form, and in as many counterparts as the Mayor shall determine; and, the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest the same and affix thereto the corporate seal of the City.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor, as provided by law.
