ORDINANCE NO. 2615

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE A CONTRACT  
BETWEEN PIERCE MANUFACTURING, INC. AND THE  
CITY OF COLUMBIA, ILLINOIS FOR THE PURCHASE OF  
A PLATFORM FIRE TRUCK

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois (the "City") has found and determined and does hereby declare that it is necessary and appropriate the City purchase a 100' platform truck for use by the Columbia Volunteer Fire Department; and,

WHEREAS, the platform truck will replace Truck 1912, a 1977 pumper truck, and Truck 1910, a 1986 rescue truck.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City has chosen Pierce Manufacturing, Inc. of Appleton, Wisconsin as the appropriate company from which to purchase the apparatus and equipment; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate this Ordinance be enacted for the use and purpose of authorizing the contract to purchase the aforementioned apparatus and equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** The recitals contained above in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference, the same as if set forth in this Section of this Ordinance verbatim, as findings of the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois.

**Section 2.** The City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois does hereby authorize and direct the Mayor to purchase the platform truck described above in the preamble of this Ordinance (and as is more particularly described in Exhibit 2, dated May 2, 2007, of the contract attached hereto).

**Section 3.** The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to make and enter into said contract with Pierce Manufacturing, Inc., in the form attached hereto, which is hereby approved as to form, and in as many counterparts as the Mayor shall determine; and, the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest the same and affix thereto the corporate seal of the City.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor, as provided by law.
