**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE CELEBRATION
2009 COMMITTEE OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA,
ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois (the "City") has found and determined and does hereby declare that it is necessary and appropriate the City establish a Celebration 2009 Committee; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate this Ordinance be enacted for the use and purpose of establishing the aforementioned committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The recitals contained above in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference, the same as if set forth in this Section of this Ordinance verbatim, as findings of the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois does hereby establish the Celebration 2009 Committee for the purposes of coordinating and organizing community events relating to the celebration of the City of Columbia's 150th year.

Section 3. The Committee and various sub-committees will function in the manners more particularly described in the proposal, in the form attached hereto, which is hereby approved as to form, and in as many counterparts as the Mayor shall determine.

Section 4. Committee members shall serve at the will of the appointing authority and any member may be removed, without cause, by the Mayor, with the consent of the City Council as is made and provided for in Section 3.1-35-10 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/3.1-35-10), as amended.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor, as provided by law.
