ORDINANCE NO. 2634

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THE SCHEDULE OF
BENEFITS OF THE VISION CARE PLAN FOR FULL-TIME
CITY EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, (the "City") provides a Vision Care Plan for each full-time employee and the employee's family, the schedule of benefits to be determined from time to time under the regular pay resolutions of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The Schedule of Benefits shall be increased as follows:

Vision Exam	\$40.00 per exam
Single Vision Lens	\$50.00 per pair
Bifocal Lens	\$100.00 per pair
Trifocal Lens	\$70.00 per pair
Lenticular Lens	\$140.00 per pair
Contact Lens	\$140.00 per pair
Frames	\$50.00 per pair

Section 2. All resolutions or ordinances of the City in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.


