ORDINANCE NO. 2678

**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM
CERTAIN BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS TO ANOTHER BUDGET
APPROPRIATION WITHIN THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, ILLINOIS
GENERAL CORPORATE FUND**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois has established a Foreign Fire Insurance Board to administer the Foreign Fire Insurance Fees received by the City under and pursuant to the Foreign Fire Insurance Company Fee Statute of the State of Illinois (65 ILCS 5/11-10-1, et. seq.); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Columbia has found and determined and does hereby declare that it is necessary and appropriate to transfer funds from various line items within the General Corporate Fund to another line item within the same fund to allow for the payment of Foreign Fire Insurance Fees received by the City to the Foreign Fire Insurance Board.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. –The City Council of the City of Columbia, Illinois hereby authorizes the transfer of funds from the following line items of the General Corporate Fund, in the amounts listed:

to the "Contingent" (001-00-44800) line item of the General Corporate Fund.

Alderman Unnerstall moved the adoption of the above and foregoing Ordinance; the motion was seconded by Alderman Hejna, and the roll call vote was as follows:


