Mayor Hutchinson called the Public Hearing before the City Council of Columbia, Illinois to order at 6:45 PM.


Aldermen in attendance were: Eberschl, Agne, Niemietz, Roessler, Huch, Piazza and Reis.


II. PURPOSE
